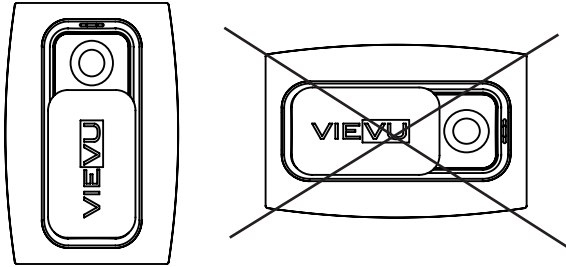


## WEARING THE VIEWU CAMERA

Use a phillips head screwdriver to attach your VIEWU camera to one of the two supplied attachment clips. To change clip orientation, you MUST loosen the screw. Do not force or you could break the clip.

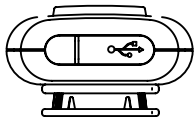
The human body naturally angles upward in the upper chest area. Most people will have to wear the camera lower on their torso than they first realize. Take some time to experiment with placement on your body.

Ensure that the camera is upright so the video will record in the proper orientation.



## RESET BUTTON

If your camera fails to respond, it may need to be reset. The reset button is a small round hole under the USB cover. Gently insert the end of a paperclip into the hole while the unit is turned on and press to reset.

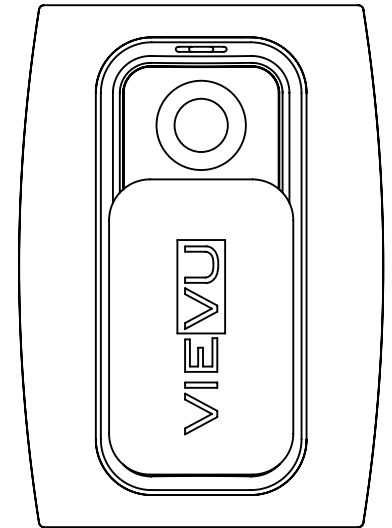

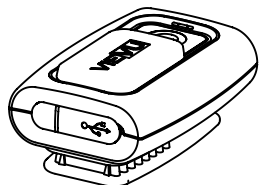

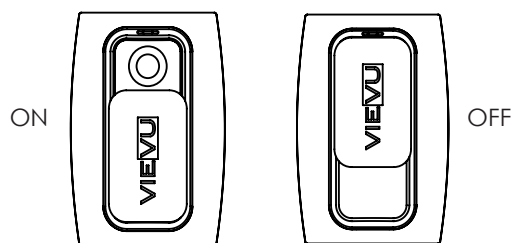
## CHARGING YOUR VIEVU

Before you start recording, it is important to fully charge the battery. You can use the included wall charger or plug your camera into your computer. Maximum charge time is approximately 3 hours.



## RECORDING

To record, slide the on/off switch on the front of the camera. The on/off switch also doubles as a lens cover when in the "off" position.



## INDICATOR LIGHT

- |                      |  |
|----------------------|--|
| Red Light            | The camera is charging. When the red light turns off, the camera is fully charged. |
| Amber Light          | The camera is connected to power and turned on.                                    |
| Blinking Red Light   | The camera has a low battery or the memory is almost full.                         |
| Blinking Green Light | The camera is recording.   |

The LED light will turn from blinking green to blinking red during recording when available memory OR battery capacity is 20% or less.

### VERIPATROL INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

These instructions explain the system requirements and how to install the VERIPATROL software on a stand alone computer or on a server.

### ADMIN GUIDE

This guide is designed for personnel assigned to administer VIEVU video files. The administrator, by using the ADMIN Application can:

1. Add or Delete users from the VERIPATROL system.
2. Add other administrators.
3. Assign cameras to users.
4. Copy video files.
5. View any video file in the VERIPATROL system.
6. Add comments to a specific video file.
7. Delete videos.

### CLIENT GUIDE

This guide is designed for users of VIEVU wearable cameras. The CLIENT Application allows the USER to:

1. Download videos from a LE series camera to the VERIPATROL system.
2. Watch videos taken with a LE series camera.
3. Mark video files to ensure they are not deleted at the automatic delete cycle.
4. Add user comments to specific video files.

## WHAT IS VERIPATROL SOFTWARE?

VIEVU VERIPATROL SOFTWARE is a video file management system that simplifies the download, storage and retrieval of video files recorded with the LE series cameras.

For the user, VERIPATROL is simple. The user only has to connect the VIEVU camera to the VERIPATROL equipped computer, turn the unit on, enter their unique, private password, and VERIPATROL handles the rest. VERIPATROL downloads the video files, and when completed, clears the cameras memory so that it is ready to record again.

For the administrator, VERIPATROL allows them to search for videos by user or date & time. The administrator can review and copy files as needed. Each time a video file is copied, reviewed or deleted, the database log records the date, time & purpose for accountability.

Plus:

1. All video files are secure.
2. Any video file can be marked for retention indefinitely for ongoing investigations or court use.
3. Unless marked, all other videos are automatically deleted based on the set retention policy to save storage space.
4. All upgrades are **free** and easily downloaded from [www.vievu.com](http://www.vievu.com).

## HOW MUCH STORAGE DO I NEED FOR VIDEOS?

This can be a difficult question to answer. The short answer, as much as you can afford. The long answer is more mathematical:

1 hour of video equals approximately 1 GB of storage space needed.

If you and/or your users record one hour every day, you can see the equation:

For example:

10 Officers x 1 hour of video a day x 90 day retention = 900GB needed.
